



PHD POSITIONS FOR HIGHLY QUALIFIED GRADUATES

The Interuniversity Center for Social Science Theory and Methodology ICS offers fully funded PhD positions for a variety of projects. The PhD students will be appointed for a four-year period, with a formal evaluation at the end of the first year. In this period the graduates will work on their individual project, leading to a doctoral dissertation.

Requirements

Excellent candidates who graduated or will graduate shortly are invited to apply, with a specialization in Sociology or related disciplines (e.g. Psychology, Educational Sciences, Economics, Mathematics, or Statistics).

We offer, in accordance with the Collective Labour Agreement for Dutch Universities, a salary of € 2.395 gross per month in the first year up to € 3.061 gross per month in the fourth year based on a full-time position.
